Indian Turtle Conservation Program (ITCP) is a collaborative nationwide initiative of Turtle Survival Alliance (www.turtlesurvival.org) and Madras Crocodile Bank Trust (www.madrascrocodilebank.org). The program was initiated in 2004 to conserve country's threatened non-marine chelonians (as well as other sympatric freshwater species) and their habitats through conservation, research and community outreach. Since then ITCP completed twelve projects and currently engaged in implementing over 6 professional projects and ten other similar initiatives in five Turtle Priority Areas (TPAs) across the country in association with various state forest departments, and government and non-government organizations of national and international repute. **The program is looking for dynamic professionals, students and volunteers**, as detailed below, for its soon-to-be started as well as future projects.
